RELEASE FROM LIABILITY - Please read carefully

I understand and accept the fact that alpine skiing/snowboarding in its various forms is a hazardous sport that has many dangers and risks. I realize that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence of this sport. I agree, as a condition of being allowed to use the ski area facility and premises, that I freely accept and voluntarily assume all risks of personal injury or death or property damage, and release Butternut Basin, Inc., and its agents, and Directors, Officers and Shareholders from any and all liability for personal injury or property damage which results in any way from negligence and conditions on or about the premises, facilities, the operations of the area including, but not limited to, grooming, snowmaking, lift operations, actions or omissions of employees or agents of the area, or my participation in skiing, snowboarding, or other activities at the area. In addition, if I am choosing to rent equipment for myself or as parent/guardian, I accept for use AS IS the equipment listed on this form or Rental records, and accept full financial responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in my possession. I understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety. In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding, skiboarding and snowblade use, the binding system will not release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation. I understand that the sport of skiing, snowboarding, snowblading, skiboarding and other recreational activities involve inherent and other risks of INJURY and DEATH, I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks or injury or death that may result from skiing/snowboarding from skiing/snowboarding/snowblade use or which relate in any way to the use of this equipment. I AGREE TO RELEASE the Butternut Rental Shop, Butternut Basin, Inc., its employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors, and the manufacturer and distributors of this equipment (collectively "Providers") from all liability from injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding/snowblading and skiboarding use, or is in any way related to use of this equipment. This agreement is governing to the applicable law of the State of Massachusetts. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS EQUIPMENT RENTAL & LIABILITY RELEASE AGREEMENT. I, THE UNDERSIGNED, HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND ACCEPT THE CONDITIONS GOVERNING ENROLLMENT IN THE STUDENT SKI/SNOWBOARDING PROGRAMS AND THE RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AGREEMENT, AN ESSENTIAL PART THEREOF. I AM SIGNING FREELY AND OF MY OWN ACCORD REALIZING IT IS BINDING UPON MYSELF, MY HEIRS AND MINORS, THAT I HAVE FULL AUTHORITY TO DO SO, REALIZING ITS BINDING EFFECT ON THEM AS WELL AS MYSELF.

**Ski Butternut invites students from Berkshire Country Day School
to participate in the following specially discounted ski and snowboard programs**

The options available to students are listed and explained below:

Eight lesson Program with or without Rental Equipment

Entitles the student to a lift ticket, lesson and rental equipment (if selected) on 8 Friday sessions, commencing January 8, 2010. Students will be bussed from BCD for lessons on January 8, 15, 22, 29, February 5, 12, 26 and March 5th, 2010. This is a "learn to ski or board" program where students are broken into lesson groups according to their age and ability. PLEASE BE ADVISED, students may be on their own for the free ski / board time. If selected, the rental option allows the student to be set up with Butternut rental equipment for each Friday session. The equipment is only available for the student on the above listed Friday lesson dates and remains at Butternut.

Berkshire Country Day School provides its' own transportation, any questions should be directed to BCD staff in regard to transportation.

Should a lesson day be missed due to inclement weather or other unforeseeable occurrences, Ski Butternut does its' best to make up the session after the last day of scheduled Friday lessons.

Season Pass

A season pass entitles the student to use Ski Butternut's facilities on any open day for the 2009/10 season. It does not include any lesson time. Passes are photo IDs and need to be picked up at the main office at Ski Butternut.

Season Pass plus 8-lesson program - please check both appropriate boxes and add column.

Ski Butternut invites all students enrolled in BCD to take advantage of a combined season pass with the 8-lesson program. This option allows the student to visit Ski Butternut on any open day of the 2009/10 season as well as participate in the Friday lesson program. This program commences on January 9, 2009. Students will be bussed from BCD for lessons on January 8, 15, 22, 29, February 5, 12, 26 and March 5th, 2010. PLEASE BE ADVISED, students may be on their own for the free ski / board time.

Berkshire Country Day School provides its' own transportation, any questions should be directed to BCD staff in regard to transportation.

Conditions of sale of season passes - Each individual season pass is not transferable. It may be used only by the person whose photograph appears thereon. In the event of a transfer or use of the pass by another, or any act which in Management's opinion is misconduct or misuse of the facilities, management may revoke the season pass at any time without refund. The season pass is to be worn in a visible area on the outside of the garment. Upon request, the season pass must be presented to any authorized Butternut representative.

CLASSIFICATION FOR SKIER TYPE - Determining your skiing ability is your responsibility. Your skier type, height, age and boot sole length are used by the Rental Shop to determine the release/retention settings of your ski bindings. Be sure to provide accurate information; any error may increase your risk of injury. Consult these descriptions to select your classification.

TYPE I SKIERS

*ski conservatively
*prefer slower speeds
*prefer easy, moderate slopes
*favor lower than average release/retention settings
*Type I settings apply to "new skiers uncertain of their classification"

TYPE II SKIERS

*ski moderately
*prefer a variety of speeds
*ski on varied terrain, including most difficult trails
*skiers who do not meet all the descriptions of either Type I or Type III

TYPE III SKIERS

*ski aggressively
*normally ski at high speeds
*prefer steeper and more challenging terrain
*favor higher than average release/retention settings
